

# Shotley Parish Plan Implementation Board

## Notes of a meeting held on 6 June 2006, Village Hall

1. The Board meeting was preceded by the above members meeting Tim Mutum and Jill Barton of Babergh District Council regarding use of the funding award made by Babergh East Local Strategic Partnership.
2. The conclusion of this discussion was that the PPIB would write to TM explaining the need to allocate a small proportion of the funding to a community pot to be used in the short term, but reassuring the BELSP that bigger ticket items would be progressed once outcomes from external events and further community consultation were more conclusive – including development of the HMS Ganges site. The letter should explain that the request for funding bids was based on the original correspondence and launched before this meeting. It should identify details of proposed community pot funding (following this PPIB meeting). TM would then seek approval to this in the immediate term (not waiting for September meeting).
3. The PPIB meeting proper then commenced, and considered the applications received from local organisations for funding from such a community pot. They were assessed on the basis of the completed Shotley Parish Council grant application forms. Members of the PPIB declared any interests as necessary, taking no part in those decisions, and these are recorded.
4. Decisions made were as follows (for more details see the forms)

Shotley Village Hall Management Committee	Sound system including induction loop (GS declared interest)	£1,000, on condition that VHMC can demonstrate ability to fund the remainder
HMS Ganges Museum	Moving and restoration of MHS Ganges figurehead	£1,500
Shotley Church Heritage 700	Access ramp	£1,000
Shotley Youth & Community Project	After-school youth club in village hall. (JN declared interest)	£1,000 (if Local Network Fund funding bid successful)

Shotley Drama Group	Lighting and sound equipment for Village Hall	£2500 requested, decision <b>deferred</b> until budget, match funding and greater clarity re Village Hall request needed
