PLACES TO VISIT – ALL WITHIN A SHORT STROLL OF THE FERRY

Landguard Fort, Felixstowe – Built in 1540 at the behest of Henry the Eighth and the last fort in England to have repelled a full scale invasion attempt. Escorted and Audio Tours available. Open every day ferry runs in 2006. Admission charges apply.

John Bradfield Port Viewing Area, Landguard Point, Felixstowe – Watch the shipping and see the Shotley Peninsula from a different angle.

Ha'penny Pier Visitor Centre, Harwich – Details of everything Harwich has to offer including the following which are Open Daily 1st May to 31st August:-

The Redoubt* – A 180 ft. circular fort built in 1808 to defend Harwich.

The Lifeboat Museum*^ – Contains an extensive history of Harwich Lifeboats.

The Maritime Museum* – Nautical displays housed in a decommissioned lighthouse with excellent views over the harbour and its shipping movements.

Beach at Dovercourt Bay near Harwich - A short bus ride or a walk along the promenade will take you to this fine blue flag beach.

SUFFOLK SAVER – CHANGES FROM 01/04/06

Changes to the Suffolk Saver Bus Pass will mean that holders of the New Pass will be able to travel FREE on any local bus in Suffolk throughout the day!

As from 1st April 2006 Suffolk residents aged 60 years and over and people with disabilities will be able to apply for the New Free Bus Pass. Suffolk Saver can be used on all **LOCAL** bus services, the Buzabout Community Car and the Shotley, Harwich and Felixstowe Foot Ferry. Using your Suffolk Saver you can travel anywhere within Suffolk. You can also travel further a field, provided your bus journey starts **or** finishes in Suffolk and does not involve a change of service outside Suffolk.

SHOTLEY PENINSULA BUZABOUT COMMUNITY CAR AND DIAL-A-RIDE SERVICE

The door to door service for anyone of any age at the cost of a bus fare (Buzabout Community Car free to valid Suffolk Saver Pass holders).

The Community Car and Dial-A-Ride services are available if there is not a bus where or when you wish to travel on the Shotley Peninsula or you are unable to use a bus. Both vehicles are wheelchair friendly but please advise the operator when booking. The operator will advise you of the appropriate service for your needs.

Use it to go to the local shops and pubs, to the doctors or to see friends on the Shotley Peninsula, to go to the cinema, the theatre, a restaurant or club in Ipswich or connect with a train at Ipswich or Manningtree Stations.

The Community Car operates between the following hours:-

Monday	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday	7:00 a.m. to Midnight
Friday	7:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. Sat.
Saturday	9:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. Sun.
Sunday	9:00 a.m. to Midnight



Requests for bookings for both the Dial-A-Ride and Community Car can be made up to seven days in advance but no later than:-

- 1:00 p.m. for travel the same evening
- 3:30 p.m. for daytime travel the following day
- 1:00 p.m. Friday for weekend travel and the following Monday
